Minutes of previous meeting 1st September 2014: acceptance proposed by ND seconded by CC

Business Arising: None other than on Agenda

Advertising: KC Kitchens-Offer £250 + VAT-----Slimming Club---After discussion, it was agreed that for short-term, programme specific ads that a free membership might be offered instead of a contractual arrangement.

Grant: Application made to developing Communities Stream for £11K over 3 years based on existing level of grant + inflation. Outputs would have to be achieved around Community Safety and Community Cohesion and evidence retained. I.e. 1 COI per hour, 1 Community news slot per programme (both day-time) + logging local voices on air from local groups. If unsuccessful, we could apply for £3K next year. Our current bank balance and the need to cut grants may be a factor as we do not fit in easily to one stream.

Insurance: trustee indemnity now required by council and libel and Slander advisable.

Quote from Zurich awaited: delegated to ND & CC to accept and finalise

Office Computer: 2 Microsoft office to be purchased at discounted price of £13 each-CM

Scheduling/programming: New poetry programme to be slotted in sat am before Weekend Works (ND offered to put on)

Concern that the pool of cover presenters was shallow.SH to consider how best to remind all volunteers about link on web-site to the schedule and whether it was feasible to identify empty slots just ahead of each week.

While day-time programme could be covered by mixed music, it was agreed that the genre of specialist programmes should be sacrosanct whoever was presenting .SH was in charge of scheduling and would use ND as a sounding board regarding any contentious matters. It was recognised that Geoff has the most opportunity to relate to other presenters and provided he worked within policy he had a useful role to assist SH.

Training: Continued concern that people from training and general enquiries are not making the step to presenting. ND had contacted those from the March course without any positive outcomes. Discussed the possibility of a bid for an additional space to allow the portable desk to be set up ready for training in a non-live environment. After a quick visit, there were concerns about security and the distance from the studio. Concerns from centre staff about finding a new home for the existing use. An issue was finding a way to simulate the news bulletin on the portable desk to give a 'mirror' of the studio desk. A donation might be required as the centre is entitled to charge and retain income.

While not ruling out a bid for the space in the future, it was agreed as a first step that a small group

Including Geoff should meet on a Saturday morning to review what was in the 'Hub' and see if the

Portable desk could be set up in there if other stuff could be thrown out or whether the centre could find space for some gear/materials. Security over essential equipment to the operation of the station might have to reviewed.

Work Experience: A problem had arisen through an arrangement being entered into against Board Policy. Embarrassment had been caused and ND would talk to the person involved and make them aware that unilateral decisions by non-board members was not acceptable.
