## **Finance Update**

Current bank balance £13768.29

Council Grant application. CC shared application with the Board and GC forwarded some amendments/inclusions to CC. RA raised we have members with physical disabilities and CC confirmed we would highlight the accessibility to the station.

<u>Geoff Ruderham</u>had keys cut for site at Halkerston after Council confirmed this was ok. CC will refund £30 charge.

After issues with the news not playing, CC checked for invoice for the service. Not received latest invoice so CC contacted Company to have this provided so we could make payment

## **Technical Update**

Telephone line going via main phone system. Teething problems but appear to be ok now.

BT invoice will show all lines for the next quarter but following invoices will be only one line and therefore cheaper.

Had some SKy News faults - not playing or very quiet. Fault is caused by the receiver in the hub. CM confirmed Sky dish is rusty so has contacted Aerial Man to have this replaced. New Sky Box has also been received.

Live From Home had some issues - drops in connections and backup MP3 not working as it should.

Transmitter at Medical Centre requires to be rebooted. Only have access Monday to Friday during Centre opening hours.

Desk repair - work outlined in minutes from 30 August 2022 will start soon. CM was on holiday and therefore unable to make a start.

#### **News Writing Workshop**

AlanT confirmed it was not a great turnout with 6 people attending each workshop, however all attendees were fully engaged and they went very well. RA confirmed he was at both and although missed the first hour of each due to being on air he found them to be very useful.

#### <u>AGM</u>

Announcement to be 21 clear days before AGM. KT to contact Jill Marsh at Community Centre to book largest room and cafeteria and let CM know so announcement can be made. SH confirmed we will have Sum Up machine to take payment of membership fee for new year.

#### **On Air Incident**

Presenter left mic open and used 'mild' swear word while talking on the telephone. Board agreed that a warning was appropriate but to make presenter aware that we would expect to be informed as soon as was reasonably possible.

Brief discussion about how to make all volunteers aware that they must make the board aware via chairman or concerns email address. Confirmed this should be added to the Volunteer agreement.
